Laser Poa Trivialis is ideal for winter overseeding of Bermudagrass tees and greens. It exhibits fast germination, shade tolerance, cold tolerance and has better spring transition than most varieties on the market today. Laser can be cut immediately after overseeding and has a medium dark color that is maintained through cool weather.

Laser has a stoloniferous growth habit for improved density plus it has fine leaf texture with a deep green color for a high quality turf area. Laser's growth habit allows it to recuperate quickly, provides excellent season long putting surface, and can tolerate an extremely low cutting height.
