Anjo is a medium-late timothy variety that grows quickly in early spring with excellent first-harvest yields. The aggressive mass formation of Anjo helps ensure good establishment and an even yield distribution. Anjo has good winter-hardiness and is easily digestible to livestock.

- Well suited for pure grass hay
- Excellent option in blends with other grasses or legumes.

### MANAGEMENT

- Seeding Rate (pure stand): 8 - 10 pounds per acre
- Seeding Rate (mixtures): 4 - 6 pounds per acre
- Planting Depth: 1/4 - 1/2 inch
- For optimum quality and yield, harvest at early boot stage
