Havana is a Poa trivialis targeted for fall and winter overseeding of bermudagrass in warm southern climates. With quick germination, fast establishment, and smooth spring transition, Havana allows for the rapid recovery of bermudagrass. Proven in overseeding trials in Arizona, Florida, and Mississippi, Havana has demonstrated excellent spring transition, very dark green color, fine leaf texture, excellent density, and a beautiful appearance on overseeded greens, tees, and all fine Bermuda turf situations. Havana distinguishes itself with excellent winter hardiness and color retention, even after significant frosts and low temperatures. Havana also demonstrates very good overall disease resistance, including good resistance to dollar spot and leaf spot. With excellent shade performance, Havana tolerates lower light settings better than other commonly used overseeding grasses, such as perennial rye and creeping bent.
